COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE
REVISED TESTIMONY

Commission Staff (Staff), by and through undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, hereby requests leave to file its testimony and as grounds therefore states:

1. This matter has been scheduled for an administrative hearing on December 6, 2006. Pursuant to Order Nos. PSC-06-0783-PCO-TI, issued September 20, 2006, Commission staff filed its Direct Testimony on October 20, 2006.

2. The purpose of Staff witness Winston's testimony was to sponsor the staff audit report of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. which addresses the Company's amended petition to recover 2005 tropical system related costs and expenses, Audit Control Number 06-255-1-1.

3. Witness Winston's testimony discussed certain information requests to BellSouth which were outstanding, and did not allow Commission staff to verify costs and expenses included in BellSouth's Petition prior to the filing deadline.

4. Subsequent to the filing of witness Winston's testimony, BellSouth provided Commission staff with additional materials that allowed it to continue the process of verifying the costs and expenses included in BellSouth's Petition.

5. Witness Winston's revised testimony incorporates staff's findings after it conducted its analysis of the additional materials provided by BellSouth.

6. Staff counsel has contacted all parties to this docket. As of the filing of this Motion, none have raised an objection to staff's request.

Wherefore, Commission staff moves the Prehearing Officer to accept the attached Revised Direct Testimony.
