PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing shall be for the Commission to make a:

- (1) Determination of recovery of natural gas storage project costs, including base gas charges and carrying costs on natural gas stored in inventory.

(2) Determination of the proposed amendment to the existing GPIF mechanism to incorporate a “dead band” around the scale of Generating Performance Incentive Points, and the effective date of the amendment, if the mechanism is changed.

JURISDICTION

Florida Public Service Commission jurisdiction over the rates and charges of investor-owned utilities is established by the provisions of Sections 366.04, 366.05, 366.06, and 366.07, Florida Statutes. Jurisdiction to consider recovery of environmental costs is established by the provisions in Section 366.8255, Florida Statutes.

PRACTICE AND PROCEDURE


These proceedings will be governed by the provisions of Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, as well as Chapters 25-6, 25-7, 25-22, and 28-106, Florida Administrative Code.
