

**Project Description**

Upgrade of the 580 MHP lift station located on Belcher Road north of Main St. The 580 lift station services the south east section of the Mid County sewer collection system. The project includes the installation of two (2) 5 hp Flygt pumps with "N" impellers, pump bases, stainless steel rail system, emergency by-pass piping, above ground manifold with 4" concrete pad and relocation of the control panel.

**Justification & Benefits**

This project is necessary due to the deteriorated condition of the existing equipment. The existing pumps are regularly removed to be deragged and repaired. The riser pipes in the wet well are leaking, which makes the pump operation very energy inefficient. In order to remove the pumps from the wet well, the entire piping system must be dismantled which is very time consuming and inefficient. The new system will provide a bypass pumping option, labor friendly pump removal system and a stand isolation and check valve configuration for each pump that will enable staff to perform maintenance on one (1) pump while the remaining pump is in service

**Alternatives**

1. RETAIN EXISTING SYSTEM: This alternative will continue to result in expensive and labor intensive repair and maintenance. Due to the style of the system it provide more opportunities for accident and or injury when maintenance is required. Power is wasted by the continued use of worn pumps and piping
2. REPLACE PUMPS AND STAND PIPES ONLY: This style of lift station construction is antiquated and does not comply with our standard specifications for lift station construction.
