COM Deficiencies CTR NFMU is in the process of preparing the financial schedules of this information a) ECR and will file it as soon as completed. GCL Other than what is reported in Del Tura's 2005 Annual Report on file with the b) OPC Commission, NFMU has had difficulty obtaining sufficient documentation of Del RCA Tura's rate base for those assets being transferred to NFMU, however, NFMU has not exhausted its resources and will provide this response upon doing so. Some SCR onsite documentation of rate base was destroyed in Hurricane Charlie and such SGA \_\_\_\_\_ documentation is being sought from other sources. SEC OTH \_\_\_\_

- c) NFMU does not expect to receive any plant capacity charges in Del Tura as all sites have been paid for at closing.
- d) The estimated cost to NFMU to interconnect the Del Tura system is approximately \$1,300,000.00.
- e) NFMU's accountants are analyzing the data and will provide this response as soon as it is completed.
- f) NFMU and its accountants are still analyzing the costs savings in order to more closely define those savings other than the obvious ones.

Additional Information

- 1) In September 2006, NFMU issued Industrial Development Bonds in the principal amount of \$5,100,000.00 that bear interest at variable rates not to exceed twelve percent (12%) per annum, and will mature on June 1, 2026.
- 2) The closing on this transaction occurred October 18, 2006.
- 3) These were not provided at closing and are being sought.
- 4) The general manager of NFMU is scheduled to meet with the Home Owners Association on January 8, 2007 and has already been in communication with the Board of Directors of the Homeowners Association regarding this matter.
- 5) NFMU has or will obtain the Del Tura supporting documentation for all rate base additions since the last time rate base was set for all assets that are being transferred to NFMU. See response to C above.
- 6) The Del Tura WWTP is a twenty-five year old package WWTP which has outlived its useful life. The plant has been subject to numerous odor complaints. Further, there is insufficient effluent disposal during the rainy season, thus, the dismantling of the plant will also eliminate the intermittent discharged surface waters.
