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3 PROCEEDINGS 1 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Call this hearing to order. 2 Staff, would you please read the notice? 3 MS. BENNETT: Pursuant to notice, this time and place 4 5 has been set for a prehearing conference in Docket Number 060642, Crystal River Unit 3 need determination uprate. 6 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. We'll now take 7 appearances. 8 MR. WALLS: Mike Walls and Dianne Triplett with 9 Carlton Fields on behalf of Progress Energy Florida. 10 MS. CHRISTENSEN: Patty Christensen on behalf of the 11 Office of Public Counsel. 12 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. 13 MS. CHRISTENSEN: And I'd also like to put an 14 appearance for Joe McGlothlin. 15 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. 16 MS. BENNETT: Lisa Bennett and Lorena Holley for the 17 Public Service Commission. 18 19 COMMISSIONER CARTER: These are all the parties? MS. BENNETT: There are additional parties who have 20 filed motions to intervene. Mr. McWhirter did contact me 21 Friday afternoon and asked that he be excused from today's 22 proceeding. 23 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. I thought I saw someone 24 coming in the back door there. Let's take five. 25

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(Recess taken.)

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2 COMMISSIONER CARTER: We're back on the record. Let 3 us deal now with the preliminary matters.

MS. BENNETT: The petition, original petition by 4 Progress included a request for cost recovery. Pursuant to the 5 prehearing officer's order, this issue was bifurcated and the 6 cost recovery through the fuel clause issue will be heard at a 7 later date by the Commission. Also there is a correction in 8 the order establishing procedure. It contains a statement that 9 PEF requests to issue a request for proposals to evaluate 10 supply-side alternatives to its proposed expansion. That's not 11 part of PEF's petition and will not need to be considered in 12 the need determination. They are asking for an exemption --13 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. 14 MS. BENNETT: -- from the Bid Rule process. And 15 there are no other preliminary matters on behalf of 16 Public Service Commission staff. 17 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. Mr. Wright, are you a 18 party to this proceeding? 19 MR. WRIGHT: Yes, sir, Commissioner. 20 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. Well, we'll have a 21

22 belated taking of appearances.

23 MR. WRIGHT: I appreciate it. I'll explain later why 24 I was late. Thank you very much.

3	COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay.
4	MR. WRIGHT: Thank you.
5	COMMISSIONER CARTER: We've just gone through the
6	taking of appearances and preliminary matters. And now I'd
7	like to what I'd like to do is proceed through the
8	prehearing order. If you I like to go step by step. If
9	there's no corrections or information, you don't really have to
10	say anything just because I'm there. Okay?
11	Okay. Let's proceed through the prehearing order.
12	Section I, any comments? Hearing none, Section II. Hearing
13	none, Section III. Hearing none, Section IV. Hearing none,
14	Section V. Hearing none, Section VI. Hearing none, Section
15	VII. Section VIII.
16	MS. BENNETT: There are a couple of changes to
17	positions, as I understand, from the parties. I believe
18	there's a stipulation between FRF and Progress. I'm not sure
19	that they're ready to present that on Issue 1.
20	COMMISSIONER CARTER: Mr. Wright, you're recognized.
21	MR. WRIGHT: Thank you, Commissioner. It's probably
22	best if I explain why I was late. I've now been married for
23	slightly less than 48 hours. I got married in Baton Rouge and
24	I just returned to town.
25	I did exchange this proposed stipulation with

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1	Mr. Walls this morning, but or actually around lunchtime,		
2	but we have not had a chance to discuss it further beyond that.		
3	Are you agreeable?		
4	MR. WALLS: Yes, Mr. Wright, if you would just change		
5	the word "waiver" to "exemption" since that comports with what		
6	we asked for.		
7	MR. WRIGHT: Great. That'll be fine. Then I think		
8	we have a stipulation on Issue 1, and we would revise our		
9	statement of basic position to comport with that. Thank you.		
10	COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. We'll give you leave to		
11	get with staff and make it so.		
12	MR. WRIGHT: Thank you. Yes, sir. Thank you.		
13	COMMISSIONER CARTER: Not a problem. And		
14	congratulations.		
15	MR. WRIGHT: Thank you, sir.		
16	MS. BENNETT: Also on Issue 8 there is no position		
17	taken yet by Progress on Issue 8, closing the docket. They may		
18	wish to take a position now. And this would give me an		
19	opportunity to remind the parties that if you take no position		
20	at this time, that becomes a no position in the prehearing		
21	order and you're precluded from taking a position after that.		
22	MS. CHRISTENSEN: The Office of Public Counsel		
23	understands that and we'll remain with no position on these		
24	issues in this docket depending on what Mr. Walls amends		
25	Issue 8 to be, but I don't anticipate changing our positions.		

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COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. Mr. Wright? 1 MR. WRIGHT: We understand and we have no objection 2 as to our position being changed to no position where 3 appropriate. There is one where we've taken yes as to 4 diversity and no position at this time as to the other. So our 5 position should just be yes as to diversity and no position as 6 to the other. And as to Issue 8, our position will simply be 7 ves or as stated. 8 COMMISSIONER CARTER: You're recognized. 9 MR. WALLS: Progress's position is that the docket 10 can be closed after resolving Issues 1 through 7. 11 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. Staff? 12 MS. BENNETT: There are no other items that need to 13 be taken up on Section VIII. 14 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. And you'll just get with 15 the parties and craft the information. I think there was 16 basically a, just a scrivener's error as you would be reporting 17 on that; correct? 18 MR. WRIGHT: Yes, sir. I used one word. I should 19 have used a different one. 20 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Not a problem. Not a problem. 21 22 So that completes Issue 8. Any other comments on Section VIII. Sorry. Whenever I hear Section VIII, 23 Issue 8? I think about a housing program. 24 Section IX. 25

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1 MS. BENNETT: Staff will prepare a comprehensive exhibit list consisting of all of the prefiled exhibits and 2 3 including a comprehensive staff exhibit list that will be entered into the record at the hearing, and we will provide the 4 5 exhibit list to parties as soon as possible for stipulation. COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. And, again, parties, if 6 you have any documents or exhibits, you know the normal 7 procedure is to get with staff on it. Okay? Is that all right 8 9 with everybody? Let's just -- if it's not broke, let's don't fix it. 10 11 Section X. MS. BENNETT: Currently there are -- the only 12 13 proposed stipulation is that between FRF and Progress, but we 14 will continue to work and anticipate having this docket, the 15 issues stipulated by the time of the hearing. COMMISSIONER CARTER: It's always good when you work 16 17 it out among yourselves. Section IX, pending motions. 18 19 MS. BENNETT: There are no pending or outstanding 20 motions. 21 COMMISSIONER CARTER: All right. Section -- excuse 2.2 me. Actually that would have been Section X for proposed 23 stipulations and Section XI for pending motions. I stand 24 corrected. 25 Section XII. FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

MS. BENNETT: Commissioner, there are no pending 1 confidentiality motions. 2 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Section XIII. Section XIV. 3 MS. BENNETT: There needs -- staff would suggest that 4 the prehearing officer make a ruling that opening statements, 5 if any, should not exceed ten minutes. 6 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Let me take five. Let's just 7 8 take five. (Recess taken.) 9 COMMISSIONER CARTER: We are back on the record in 10 Docket Number 060642-EI. We were on Section XIII, then Section 11 Now we are on -- I guess now we'll go from sections to 12 XIV. 13 numbers, Roman Numeral 6. Any other matters? MS. BENNETT: Not from staff. 14 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay. Any of the parties? 15 MR. WRIGHT: No, sir. 16 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Okay.
