If Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation is anticipating not meeting the May 8, 2007 due date, the Company will have to request a waiver of the above-referenced rule in sufficient time for the waiver request to be processed. Section 120.542, Florida Statutes, requires that any requests for waivers or variances from rules have to be noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly. Any requested change from the rule requires a 30 day comment period, after which the Commission must grant or deny the request within 90 days of its receipt.
