EMBARQ FLORIDA, INC.'S RENEWED REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION (Document No. 05112-05)

On August 3, 2005 the Commission issued Order No. PSC-05-0799-CFO-TL, granting the Request for Confidential Classification filed by Sprint-Florida, Incorporated ("Sprint") the predecessor company for Embarq Florida, Inc. ("Embarq") for certain information included with Sprint's Petition for Storm Cost Recovery. The specific information that was the subject of the Order included:

Lines 4-9 of Column B and line 11 of Exhibit C attached to Attachment A of Sprint's Petition (Document No. 05112-05)

In the Order, the Commission recognized that the information met the criteria for confidential classification set forth in section 364.183, Florida Statutes, in that it is information the release of which would impair the competitive business of Sprint. The Order stipulated that it expired in 18 months unless a "renewed request for confidential classification" was filed by Sprint. The confidential information is already on file with the Commission. A redacted copy of the information is attached to this request.

Based on the foregoing, Embarq respectfully requests that the Commission grant Embarq's Renewed Request for Confidential Classification, continue the exemption of the information from disclosure under chapter 119, Florida Statutes, and issue any

appropriate protective order, protecting the information from disclosure while it is maintained at the Commission.
