The Florida Public Service Commission is currently involved in a water and wastewater rate proceeding with Aqua. An important part of this proceeding is the quality of service provided by this utility. A major component of our quality of service recommendation is the consideration of the utility's compliance. It is essential that your staff answer the questions in the attached prefiled testimony.

Aqua has only one water system in Palm Beach County (Southeast District) which is Lake Osbourne (WTP - PWS ID # 4500768).

For your convenience, we have emailed you a copy of the testimony. The testimony is in MsWord format. The answers can be printed by hand on the spaces provided in the testimony. Since the standard language is in our computers, we can insert the answers, thus conserving your secretarial resources.

A hearing is tentatively scheduled for this proceeding in Tallahassee on July 5-6 and July 11-13, 2007. The staff selected to complete the testimony must be available for questioning on these dates. If we can get all involved parties to agree, the testimony can be entered into the record undisputed. Consequently, your staff's presence at the hearing would not be necessary.


