**JOINT STATUS REPORT OF  
WITHLACOOCHEE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE AND PROGRESS ENERGY FLORIDA  
Re: Territorial Agreement Customer Transfers**

This status report is submitted pursuant to Commission Order No. PSC-05-0965-PAA-EU, issued in Docket No. 040133-EU, which approved the currently effective territorial agreement between WREC and Progress Energy Florida.

**WREC/PEF Customer Transfer Updates:**

**(Phase 1: Transfers Complete-March 1, 2006)**

**Under “Phase 1” of the customer transfers delineated in the currently effective territorial agreement between WREC and PEF, the following customer transfers have been completed:**

- Majestic Oaks Development- Hernando County: Under the current territorial agreement, the entire Majestic Oaks Development in Hernando County, including 452 lots previously served by PEF, was transferred to WREC. This transfer has been completed.
  
- Masaryktown South of County Line Road- North Pasco County: Under the current territorial agreement, the above-listed portion of the Masaryktown area, including approximately 366 customers previously served by PEF, was transferred to WREC. This transfer has been completed.

- Pasco Well Field- South Pasco County: Under the current territorial agreement, the above-listed portion of the Pasco Well Field area, including approximately 706 customers previously served by WREC, was transferred to PEF. This transfer has been completed.
- East Gate- South Pasco County: Under the current territorial agreement, the East Gate Estates area, including approximately 78 customers previously served by WREC, was transferred to PEF. This transfer has been completed.

**(Phase 2: Transfers Complete-January 19, 2007)**

**Under “Phase 2” of the customer transfers delineated in the currently effective territorial agreement between WREC and PEF, the following customer transfers have been completed”**

- Trilby- North Pasco County and East Hernando County: Under the current territorial agreement, the above-listed portion of the Trilby area, including 1,671 customers previously served by PEF, was transferred to WREC. This transfer has been completed.
- Seven Springs- South Pasco County: Under the current territorial agreement, the above-listed area near Seven Springs in South Pasco County, including approximately 1,754 customers previously served by WREC, was transferred to PEF. This transfer has been completed.

- Oranewood Mobile Home Park- South Pasco County: Under the current territorial agreement, the Oranewood Mobile Home Park in South Pasco County, including approximately 257 customers previously served by WREC, was transferred to PEF. This transfer has been completed.

**The status of the remainder of the customer transfers to be effectuated under the current territorial agreement is as follows:**

- The remaining customer transfers are on schedule to be transferred within the requirements of the agreement, by April 6, 2008.
