

The MUUC requests oral argument on its response and on FPL's effective motion to "reject MUUC's Issues 5 to 8" because the MUUC believes that oral argument will help the Commission to fully comprehend and air the issues that attend FPL's motion and the MUUC's positions with respect to the issues that FPL's seeks to have "rejected."

This matter raises issues that are somewhat complicated by the changes in the procedural posture of the case occasioned by FPL's having amended its initial petition in September 2006, by which it changed the nature of this docket from one of just approving a 25% credit for government-sponsored OH-to-UG¹ conversion projects to one of approving a new CIAC formula. Oral argument will help the Commission fully comprehend the MUUC's concerns that issues relating to the implementation of FPL's new UG CIAC formula and related provisions need to be addressed, and are appropriate for consideration in, this docket.

The abbreviations used herein are the same as the abbreviations used in the MUUC's response to FPL's motion filed with the Commission concurrently with this request.
