**RE:** Recommendation to the Office of General Counsel – Docket No. 070148-TL – Petition for expedited review of NXX-X code denial by North American Numbering Plan Administration for Crawfordville exchange, by Embarq Florida, Inc.

---

On February 16, 2007, Embarq Florida, Inc. (Embarq) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the Clermont exchange, Clermont (CFMTFLXADS0) switch. Embarq requested one (1) 1,000 consecutive block of numbers, to meet a customer's request for 40 numbers. On February 16, 2007, Embarq's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust utilization criteria.

On March 6, 2007, Embarq filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order No. PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the Embarq petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (March 27, 2007), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide Embarq the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Clermont exchange, Clermont (CFMTFLXADS0) switch. Also, please allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued. If you have any questions, please call Catherine Beard at (850) 413-7080.
