Attached please find revised tariff sheets for Lee County Electric Cooperative ("LCEC") to be effective April 1, 2007:

- Rate Schedule SL-2 Public Street and Highway Lighting Electric Service, Ninth Revised Sheet No. 17.0 canceling Eighth Revised Sheet No. 17.0
- Rate Schedule SL-2 Public Street and Highway Lighting Electric Service, Sixth Revised Sheet No. 17.1 canceling Fifth Revised Sheet No. 17.1
- Rate Schedule OL-2 Private Area Lighting Electric Service, Ninth Revised Sheet No. 18.0 canceling Eighth Revised Sheet No. 18.0
- Rate Schedule OL-2 Private Area Lighting Electric Service, Fifth Revised Sheet No. 18.1 canceling Fourth Revised Sheet No. 18.1

These sheets are being revised to reflect changes in the monthly charges for the 150 watt HPS decorative fixture, the addition of a new 175 watt HPS decorative fixture, a change in the cost recovery period for the 13 foot decorative concrete pole, and the replacement of the 13 foot decorative octagonal concrete pole with an 18 foot decorative concrete pole. All of the rate changes were calculated in the same manner as the previously approved rates.

150 watt HPS decorative fixture – The average monthly kWh usage was incorrectly shown as 64 kWh instead of 69 kWh. This has been corrected and resulted in the energy charge being adjusted to reflect the proper consumption. In addition, a new fixture is being utilized that will make this offering "Dark Skies" compliant. The increased cost of the new fixture resulted in the increase in the monthly fixture charge.

175 watt HPS decorative fixture – This is a new fixture offering. The energy consumption, energy charge, and fixture charge were calculated using the same methodology as the previously approved rates.

13' Decorative Concrete Pole – The decrease in the monthly pole charge is due to an increase in the useful life of the pole from 10 to 20 years.

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18' Decorative Concrete Pole – This is a new pole that replaces the 13' decorative octagonal concrete pole which is no longer being offered in LCEC's lighting program. The rate for this pole was calculated using the same methodology previously utilized in setting pole rates.
