3 Service Commission Staff.

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P R O C E E D I N G S

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2 CHAIRMAN EDGAR: And Item 11 we also have an oral
3 modification.

4 MR. FLETCHER: Commissioners, Bart Fletcher with
5 Commission staff. Staff has two oral modifications to its
6 recommendation. First on Page 11 in the recommendation
7 paragraph of Issue 4 --

8 CHAIRMAN EDGAR: Okay. Hold on. Let us get there.
9 Okay.

10 MR. FLETCHER: On Line 3 starting with, "Aqua's
11 attestation that," the following words "it does not have any
12 outstanding" should be stricken and replaced with "the amount
13 of Aqua." And then on the fourth line of that same sentence
14 the words "is capped at 40 million" should be added.

15 And for consistency a similar change should be, also
16 be made in the staff analysis section. These changes do not
17 affect staff's recommendation to approve a corporate
18 undertaking by Aqua America, Inc., to guarantee any potential
19 refund of revenues collected under interim conditions.

20 Second, staff would like to note that for
21 informational purposes the rates listed on the rate schedules
22 4A and 4B of the various systems under the column "Utility
23 Requested Final" are incorrect. The rates represent the
24 standalone rates. However, the utility is proposing countywide
25 uniform rates. Staff will revise the schedules for the order,

1 and the interim order will reflect the correct requested final
2 rates. This change does not affect staff's recommendation on
3 the interim rates as the recommended interim rates are correct.

4 CHAIRMAN EDGAR: Thank you, Mr. Fletcher.

5 Commissioners, any questions? No? Okay. Is there a
6 motion?

7 COMMISSIONER CARTER: Move staff.

8 COMMISSIONER McMURRIAN: Second.

9 CHAIRMAN EDGAR: Item 11 is approved with the
10 modification.
