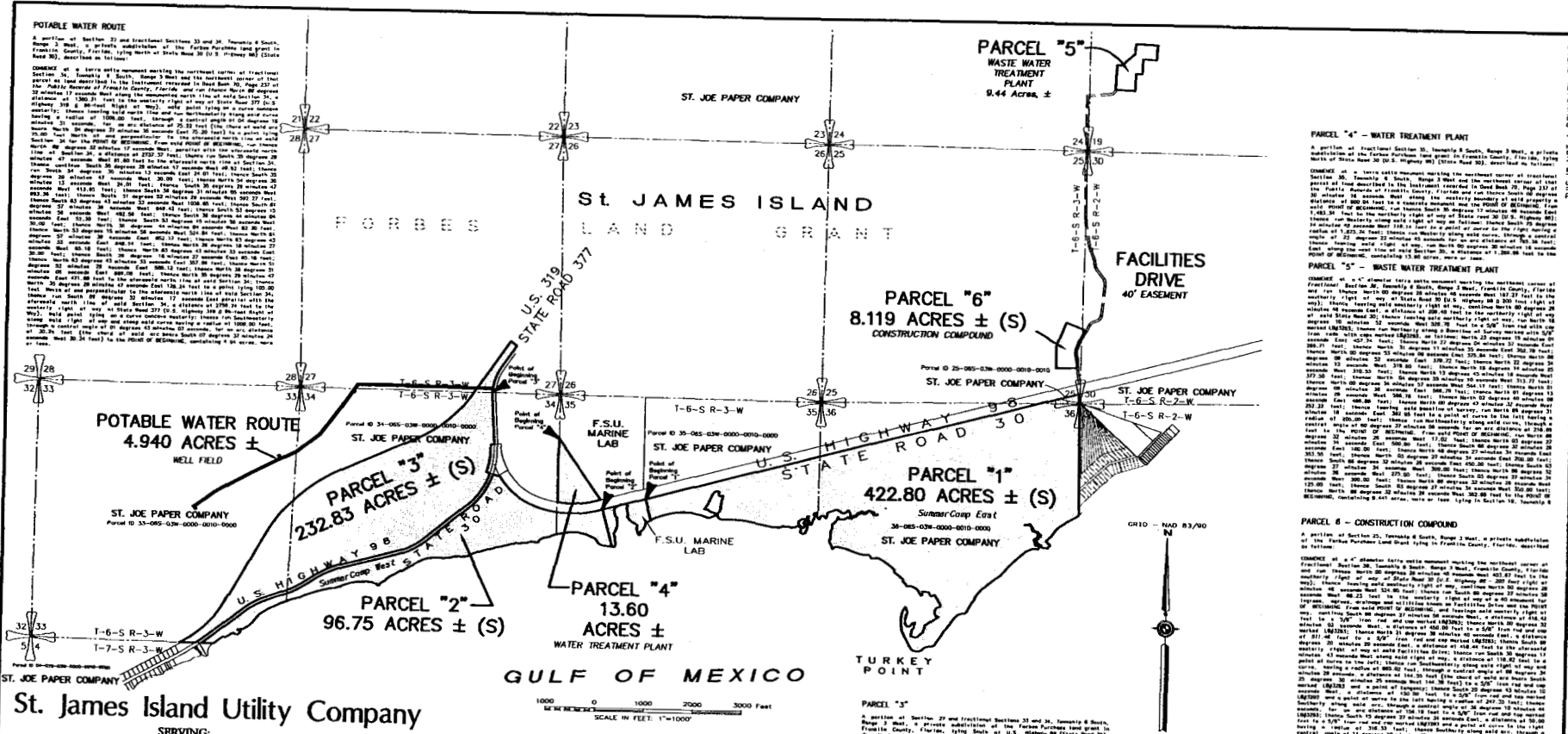

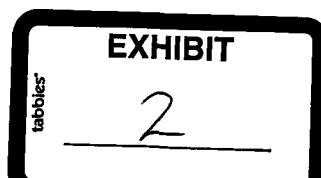

The Wastewater Treatment Plant
