

**LEVEL 3 COMMUNICATIONS, LLC'S
PROPOSED ISSUES LIST**

Level 3 Communications, LLC ("Level 3"), by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to the Staff Recommendation dated April 12, 2007 regarding the scheduling of an Issues Identification Meeting, hereby submits its Proposed List of Issues.

Issue 1: Does the Florida Public Service Commission have jurisdiction over Neutral Tandem's request to compel direct interconnection between Neutral Tandem and Level 3?

Issue 2: To the extent the Commission asserts jurisdiction over Neutral Tandem's Petition, is the Commission's jurisdiction preempted by federal law?

Issue 3: If the Commission asserts jurisdiction over Neutral Tandem's Petition, does Neutral Tandem have standing to seek relief under Sections 364.16 and 364.162, Florida Statutes?

Issue 4: If the Commission asserts jurisdiction over Neutral Tandem's Petition and determines that Neutral Tandem has standing to bring its Petition, does Level 3 have an obligation to continue to terminate Neutral Tandem's traffic?

Issue 5: If the Commission determines that Level 3 does have an obligation to continue to terminate Neutral Tandem's traffic:

(a) If so, for what period of time is Level 3 under an obligation to terminate Neutral Tandem's transit traffic?

(b) If so, what are the appropriate rates, terms and conditions for the termination by Level 3 of Neutral Tandem's transit traffic?




