Lisa, the confidential classification granted by the attached orders will expire on April 26. FPL will need to file extension requests unless Staff is in a position to return the documents at this point. As you can see, Order No. PSC-05-1049 concerns responses to Staff's Fifth Set of Interrogatories in Docket No. 050001-EI that were served in October 2005 and related to coal supply and transportation contract information. Order No. PSC-05-1045 concerns Schedules E/ A12 and E 12 of Appendix III to the testimony of Gerry Yupp, filed September 9, 2005 (also in Docket No.

050001-EI), which are related to pricing for short-term capacity purchases.

I am hopeful that the Commission does not need either of these categories of information any longer and can return them. Would you please check and let me know?
