

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)(1), Florida Administrative Code, hereby gives notice of intent to request confidential classification of certain material contained in an 11 page document entitled "Procurement of Solid Fuel Transportation Services 2009-2013," dated April 30, 2007, (hereinafter "proxy information") and states:

1. Rule 25-22.006(3)(a) provides in material part "prior to the Staff obtaining any material, a utility or other person may receive temporary exemption from Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, by filing a notice of intent to request confidential classification." Rule 25-22.006(3)(d) provides in material part, "All material that . . . is subject to a notice of intent to request confidential classification . . . shall be exempt from Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and will be accorded stringent internal procedural safeguards against public disclosure."

2. Tampa Electric Company's proxy information contains confidential proprietary business information. Accordingly, Tampa Electric intends to seek confidential classification with respect to these confidential materials. The company will file a formal request for confidential treatment of the proxy information within the time frame provided in the Commission's rule on confidentiality.


