JOINT MOTION REQUESTING COMMISSION APPROVAL OF SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

ALAFAYA UTILITIES, INC. ("Alafaya" or "Utility"), and the OFFICE OF PUBLIC COUNSEL ("OPC") file this Joint Motion requesting the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") to approve the attached Settlement Agreement. In support of this Joint Motion, Alafaya and OPC state:

1. Alafaya and OPC have entered into a Settlement Agreement resolving OPC's Petition on Proposed Agency Action Order No. PSC-07-0130-SC-SU, in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement. A copy of the Settlement Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

2. Alafaya and OPC have entered into the Settlement Agreement to avoid the time, expense and uncertainty associated with adversarial litigation, in keeping with the Commission's long-standing policy and practice of encouraging parties in protested proceedings to settle issues whenever possible. For these reasons, Alafaya and OPC request the Commission to expeditiously issue a Final Order approving the Settlement Agreement without modification and close Docket No. 060256-SU.

3. Pending Commission consideration of the Settlement Agreement, Alafaya and OPC request the Commission to suspend discovery and all events currently scheduled in the

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
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CASR for this Docket until such time as the Commission acts on this Motion.




