By letter received January 17, 2007, Verizon Florida Inc. filed a request for approval of unitary rate amendment to the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement between Verizon Florida Inc. and SBC Long Distance, LLC d/b/a SBC Long Distance d/b/a AT&T Long Distance. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was April 17, 2007.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on April 13, 2007 and May 8, 2007. The agreement met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.5.d of the Administrative Procedures Manual.
