PETITION ON PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION SYSTEMS OF PINE ISLAND, INC. (the *Utility*), by and through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Section 120.57, Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-22.029(3) and 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, files this Petition, objecting to Order No. PSC-07-0426-PAA-SU (*Order*) of the Florida Public Service Commission (*Commission*) issued May 15, 2007, and states:

Preliminary Matters

4. The Utility received a copy of the Order on May 15, 2007.
5. The interests of the Utility is substantially affected by the Order in that a refund and rate reduction were ordered. The specific facts that the Utility contends warrant reversal or modification of the Order are as follows:
 - (a) The refund amounts are overstated as follows:
 - (1) For the Test Year ending 12/31/06, wastewater rate base is understated.
 - (2) For all years, the salary expense reduction purportedly to be consistent with adjustments from the last rate case was erroneous.
 - (b) Addressing the refund on a period by period basis is erroneous.
6. Each of the foregoing matters involve disputed issues of material fact.
7. The Order establishes June 5, 2007 as the date by which petitions must be filed.
8. Chapter 367.081, Florida Statutes, is the specific statute that the Utility contends requires reversal or modification of the Order.
9. This Petition is filed for the purpose of seeking the Commission's action with respect to:
 - (a) Determining the appropriate test year wastewater rate base for the year ended 12/31/06.
 - (b) Determining the appropriate salary expense.
 - (c) Determining the amount of refund based on the total expenditures on capital improvements as of the date of Commission action, instead of on a period by period basis.

WHEREFORE, the Utility hereby protests and objects to Order No. PSC-07-0426-PAA-

SU as to the specific issues raised in this Petition, and petitions the Commission to conduct a formal evidentiary hearing, under the provisions of Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, and further petitions that such hearing be scheduled at a convenient time within or as close as practical to the Utility's certificated service area.


