Specifically, the confidential information consists of pricing terms for coal and natural gas offered to and purchased by Gulf Power in connection with Requests for Proposals issued by Gulf Power in 2006. Disclosure of this information would negatively impact Gulf's ability to negotiate pricing favorable to its customers in the future. In addition, potential counterparties may refuse to enter into contracts with Gulf in the future or would charge higher prices if the contract terms were made public. A formal request for confidential classification will be filed within the time period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, if the Staff determines that the information will be retained by the Commission and not returned to Gulf Power Company within the specified time period.
