Gulf Power Company ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or "the Company"], by and through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby gives notice that it intends to request confidential classification for portions of Gulf Powers's response to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories to Gulf Power Company (Nos. 1-10). Copies of the confidential documents are attached hereto as exhibit "A".

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3. A portion of Gulf Power Company's responses to interrogatories numbered 1, 2, 4 and 5 contain proprietary confidential business information regarding contractual matters which would cause irreparable harm to Gulf Power, the entities with whom it has entered into contracts and, most importantly, to Gulf's customers if such information were disclosed to the general public. The information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to § 366.093(d) and (e), Florida Statutes. Specifically, the confidential information consists of pricing terms for coal and natural gas offered to and purchased by Gulf Power in connection with Requests for Proposals issued by Gulf Power in 2006. Disclosure of this information would negatively impact Gulf's ability to negotiate pricing favorable to its customers in the future. In addition, potential counterparties may refuse to enter into contracts with Gulf in the future or would charge higher prices if the contract terms were made public. A formal request for confidential classification will be filed within the time period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, if the Staff determines that the information will be retained by the Commission and not returned to Gulf Power Company within the specified time period. In the event the Staff determines that it will retain this information, Gulf Power Company requests to be notified, through the undersigned counsel, prior to the expiration of the period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a).
