Re: AT&T Florida's Supplement to Response to the 2007 Storm Preparedness Data Request

Dear Ms. Cole:

On May 11, 2007, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida") submitted its response (including exhibits) to the Florida Public Service Commission Staff's 2007 Storm Preparedness Data Request (the "Storm Data Response") under a claim of confidentiality. On June 15, 2007, AT&T Florida narrowed its claim of confidentiality to certain information contained in the Storm Data Response, and submitted two (2) redacted copies and one (1) highlighted copy of the Storm Data Response.

In item 8 of the Storm Data Response, AT&T Florida referenced a spreadsheet outlining certain data the company uses to evaluate network reliability, which AT&T Florida attached as Exhibit 9. At the time of the original filing, AT&T Florida did not have results for the last four measures on the spreadsheet and indicated that it would supplement Exhibit 9 at a later date.

AT&T Florida submits an updated Exhibit 9 which contains this supplemental data under the same claim of confidentiality set forth in its June 15,



Explanation of Proprietary Information

1. This information consists of internal methods and procedures and is considered by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida") to be proprietary confidential business information within the scope of Section 364.183(3) of the Florida Statutes. The information is intended to be and is treated by AT&T Florida as private, and has not otherwise been disclosed to the public. Additionally, competitors of AT&T Florida should not be able, for no charge, to avail themselves of internal methods and procedures that AT&T Florida spent time and monetary resources to develop.
2. This information contains results on equipment/facility performance and is considered to be proprietary confidential business information within the scope of Section 364.183(3) of the Florida Statutes. The information is intended to be and is treated by AT&T Florida as private, and has not otherwise been disclosed to the public. Further, the disclosure of this information would cause harm to the Company's business operations as third parties may attempt to take the information out of context and use it to form a predicate for claims or lawsuits against the Company. To the extent a third party had a valid claim or lawsuit against the Company, that party would have the opportunity to seek this information through the discovery process in a legal action. AT&T Florida does not concede that such claims or lawsuits would have merit and, to the contrary, believes that its infrastructure has performed well in past storms.
3. This information is the product of an internal audit and, thus, is considered proprietary confidential business information by the Company within the scope of Section 364.183(3) of the Florida Statutes.
4. This information represents security measures, systems, or procedures related to storm preparedness and/or recovery efforts and, thus, is considered proprietary confidential business information by the Company within the scope of Section 364.183(3) of the Florida Statutes.
