On March 1, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its Request For Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, for certain information contained in FPSC Document No. 01382-07. Attached to its request, AT&T Florida submitted another copy of the documents previously identified as FPSC Document No. 01382-07: the second copy was identified as **FPSC Document No. 01943-07**.

AT&T Florida claims the information in Document Nos. 01382-07 and 01943-07 for which confidential classification is requested contains confidential business information related to competitive interests utilized by AT&T Florida to conduct its business and has not been disclosed to the public. AT&T Florida claims that public disclosure of this information would cause harm to AT&T Florida. The information subject to the request for confidential classification relates to AT&T Florida's estimated costs for the installation of network facilities in two private subdivisions, and AT&T Florida's net present value cash flow analysis for the potential revenues generated from those two private subdivisions.
