

**AQUA UTILITIES FLORIDA, INC.'S
UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION
OF TIME TO FILE REBUTTAL TESTIMONY TO
CONCERNS RAISED AT CUSTOMER SERVICE HEARINGS
AND REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED RULING**

Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc. ("AUF"), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby moves for a seven (7) day extension of time to file and serve its Rebuttal Testimony (and Exhibits) to concerns raised at the customer service hearings. AUF also requests that the time for the filing and service of such rebuttal testimony and exhibits be tolled pending a ruling on this Motion. In support of this Request, AUF states as follows:

1. Pursuant to Order No. PSC-07-0540-PCO-WS issued June 28, 2007, AUF is required to file rebuttal testimony and exhibits addressing concerns raised at the customer service hearings on or before August 21, 2007.

2. AUF is currently engaged in a number of significant tasks in this proceeding. These tasks include addressing and responding to specific customer complaints raised at customer service hearings, the review and analysis of prefiled testimony and exhibits recently filed by the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"), responding to on-going discovery requests served by OPC and the Commission Staff, the preparation of rebuttal testimony and exhibits addressing issues raised at the customer service hearings, and preparation for requested oral argument on the Joint Motion to


Dismiss filed by OPC and the Attorney General, State of Florida (“Attorney General”).

3. In light of the substantial work load as described above, AUF respectfully requests an extension of time of seven (7) days to file and serve its rebuttal testimony and exhibits addressing concerns raised at the customer service hearings. In light of the current due date of August 21, 2007 for the filing of such rebuttal testimony and exhibits, AUF requests that the Prehearing Officer rule on this Motion on an expedited basis.

4. Counsel for AUF has conferred with counsel for OPC and with counsel for the Attorney General and is authorized to represent that these parties do not object to the relief requested in this Motion.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, AUF respectfully requests that the Prehearing Officer grant this Motion on an expedited basis, allowing AUF an additional seven (7) days to file its rebuttal testimony and exhibits addressing concerns raised at the customer service hearings.


