MOTION TO TERMINATE PROCEEDINGS AS MOOT

Verizon Access Transmission Services ("Verizon") moves that these proceedings be terminated as moot. As grounds for its motion, Verizon states that today it is filing a Notice of Adoption of Interconnection Agreement Between AT&T Communications of the Southern States, LLC d/b/a/ AT&T and Embarq Florida, Inc. (the "Agreement"). Effective today, the Agreement replaces in its entirety the existing interconnection agreement between Verizon and Sprint-Florida, Incorporated (the predecessor of Embarq Florida, Inc.) dated March 1, 2002. Because Verizon has adopted an interconnection agreement to replace the previous agreement between the parties, there is no longer a case or controversy to be resolved. These proceedings are therefore moot and should be terminated.
