

**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S
REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION
AND MOTION FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby requests confidential classification of a single page document entitled Modified Language for "Regulatory Modifications" Section of RFP, at Pages 12-13, and as grounds therefor, says:

1. On July 27, 2007 Tampa Electric Company submitted a request for confidential classification on the draft Request for Proposals ("RFP") it submitted on July 6, 2007. That request set forth justification for treating confidentially all of the terms and provisions of the RFP.

2. The single page of modified language that is the subject of this request is equally sensitive substitute language for one of the sections of the RFP previously submitted. The modified language in question is entitled to confidential classification for the same reasons set forth in the July 27, 2007 Request for Confidential Classification which justifications are incorporated herein by reference.

3. Public disclosure of the modified language would be adverse to the interests of Tampa Electric and its customers for the same reasons as set forth in the July 27 Request for Confidential Classification.


