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PRELIMINARY NOVEMBER 2007 DATA NOTIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Georgia (“AT&T Georgia”) is considering making the changes described in this document to generate results for the November 2007 data month. Results for the November 2007 data month will be posted as follows:

Preliminary results	December 21, 2007
Final results	December 31, 2007

AT&T Georgia provides Data Notifications each month in compliance with the SQM Plan. This order specifies that when AT&T Georgia proposes making any changes to the methods by which performance data is calculated, it must provide written notice. This notice must be provided on the first business day of the month before the data month in which the change will be made. AT&T Georgia must also provide notification if it is considering making changes to the method of calculating data for the following month.

ENCORE Releases may affect monthly data flows from the source systems (e.g., LEO, LESOG, etc.) that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. AT&T Georgia will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as ENCORE Releases are implemented.

System releases related to the merger between BellSouth and AT&T may affect monthly data flows from the source systems that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. AT&T Georgia will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as system changes are implemented.

Provisioning Measurements

- (1) *Affected Measures:* P-11 (SOA)

Description of Change: Currently, AT&T Georgia is displaying results on the Service Order Accuracy CLEC specific report by OCN. AT&T Georgia proposes to display the results at the parent company/OCN level in accordance with the SQM report structure for this measure. (RQ9062)

Impact of Change: This change will have no impact to reported results.

Special Access Measurements

- (2) *Affected Measures:* SA-7 (PDC – Percent Cancellation After FOC Due Date)

Description of Change: Currently, the Past Due Circuits – “Percent Cancellation After FOC Due Date” report is only reporting records that are past due from a previous month

and were completed/canceled in the current month, as the basis for this report. AT&T Georgia proposes to include all past due records as the basis for this report. (RQ9303)

Impact of Change: For May 2007 data, there was no change to the metric in Florida or Georgia.
