St. James Island Utility Company, Inc. ("St. James " or "Utility"), by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Section 367.045(2), Florida Statutes and Rule 25-30.036, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files this Follow-up Application for Amendment to Certificate Nos. 621-W and 534-S to extend its water and wastewater service to include certain territory in Franklin County, Florida. In support of this follow-up application, St. James states as follows:

1. The name and address of the applicant utility is: St. James Island Utility Company, 3800 Esplanade Way, Suite 100, Tallahassee, Florida 32311.
2. The names and address of the utility's authorized representatives are: Kenneth A. Hoffman, Martin P. McDonnell, Rutledge, Ecenia, Purnell & Hoffman, P.A., 215 South Monroe Street, Suite 420, Tallahassee, Florida 32301.

PART 1: SYSTEM INFORMATION

- A. Water. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a statement describing the proposed types of water service to be provided, a description of the types of customers anticipated to be served by the extension, and evidence that the utility owns the land where the utility treatment facilities that will serve the proposed territory are, or will be located.
- B. Wastewater. Attached Exhibit A also contains a description of the types of customers anticipated to be served by the wastewater extension, and evidence that the utility

PART II: FINANCIAL AND TECHNICAL INFORMATION

By Order No. PSC-04-0755-PAA-WS, the Public Service Commission granted St. James' application for original water and wastewater certificates to serve the summer camp development in Franklin County. Order No. PSC-04-075-PAA-WS is the most recent Commission Order establishing or amending St. James' rates and charges.

PART III: TERRITORY DESCRIPTION AND MAPS

Territory description and maps have previously been supplied to the Commission in the original application filed by St. James in the instant docket filed April 5, 2007 and the amended application by St. James Utility filed April 13, 2007.



Dear Sirs:

I, Des O'Neill am Vice-President of St. James Island Utility Company and hereby state under oath the following:

1. The proposed new territory requested in St. James' Application for Quick Take Amendment to its Water and Wastewater Certificates includes a maximum of twenty-five (25) equivalent residential connections "ERCs" within its current service territory at the time the territory is at build out.
2. To the best of my knowledge, there is no other utility in the area of the proposed territory that is willing and capable of providing a reasonably adequate service to the new territory.
3. The proposed requested areas contain: a) the St. James Island Utility's water and wastewater treatment plant which the utility intends to serve with potable water and; b) St. Joe's administrative offices, which the utility intends to serve with both potable water and wastewater. The business requesting the water and wastewater service has demonstrated that the service is necessary, as otherwise service is not available.
