The factors are a mathematical calculation based on the resolution of company-specific issues. Staff asks for administrative authority to review the calculations reflecting the Commission's vote and include the resulting factors in the Order.

- 8. What should be the effective date of the new environmental cost recovery factors for billing purposes?**

The factors should be effective beginning with the specified environmental cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2008 through December 2008. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2008 and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2008, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.

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
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
