**Re: VERIZON REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF NUMBERING DENIAL**

Dear Ms. Cole:

Verizon Florida LLC (Verizon) is preparing to deliver services to customers in the state of Florida using new packet switching equipment. This process is part of Verizon's transformation to an advanced broadband network. In some installations, when a customer purchases Verizon's FiOS high speed internet service, the customer's existing voice service will be moved from the existing end office circuit switch to the newly installed packet switch. There will be no changes to the customer's voice service or rates.

The new packet switch is not replacing the existing circuit switch but rather it will function in parallel with the existing circuit switched network. In order for Verizon to begin offering service to its customers using the new packet switch by January 2008 Verizon must start system test and verification in November 2007. Verizon requests a waiver to permit the assignment of the required Location Routing Number (LRN) in the 952 LATA in order to support Local Number Portability (LNP) and Telephone Number Pooling (TNP).

On August 20, 2007, Verizon applied to the Pooling Administrator (PA) for a new thousand's block of numbers. The application was denied because Verizon's application did not satisfy the Months-to-Exhaust and Utilization criteria to be assigned a thousands-block from a new NXX code. Verizon requests that the Commission use its delegated authority to waive the Months-to-Exhaust and Utilization requirements so that Verizon may be assigned the required NXX code to create one LRN in the LATA identified above. Verizon will return nine unused thousands-blocks in the NXX code to the appropriate rate center pool.


