**NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST

Progress Energy Florida, Inc., ("PEF" or "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), submits this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of confidential documents regarding Hines Unit 4 to Staff's inquiry on September 14, 2007.

Specifically, the documents Staff has requested contain sensitive business information concerning contractual rate information of third parties, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the Company to negotiate contracts on favorable terms, and that could negatively impact the competitive business interests of both PEF and its contractual counterparties. Attached as Exhibit A is a confidential, highlighted copy of the above referenced documents.



There were several entries of sub-categories listed for each major category.

Please provide the current estimated/actual value for each subcategory along with an explanation of whether the change was caused by a change in scope, escalation in materials or labor, or some combination of scope and escalation.
