Dear Chairwoman Edgar:

Bellsouth has raised its rates, with the approval of the Public Service Commission, to recover storm damages.

They canceled their storm-damage insurance in 2006. Also in 2006, they did *not* create a cash reserve for storm damage. Both of these actions led to their "losses." At the same time, both actions actually increased their reported bottom-line profits, which enabled their senior executives to receive larger bonuses based on those profits. This also made the company's stock more attractive to investors, and to their merger with AT&T.

Why are we consumers paying for this?

When will "public service" become part of the Commission's mission, as opposed to being just part of the name?

We grade your activity, and your obvious lack of concern for the public, with an F!
