The purpose of this letter is to notify the Director of the Division of Economic Regulation, pursuant to Florida Public Service Commission Rule 25-17.0832(1)(a), Florida Administrative Code, that Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") and Manatee Green Power, LLC ("Manatee") have entered into a negotiated purchased power contract (the "Contract").

The Contract is for purchase and sale of energy and firm capacity, as well as defined environmental Green Attributes, from a new renewable generating facility that Manatee proposes to construct in Manatee County, Florida. Execution of the contract was completed on November 5, 2007. Accordingly, FPL provides this notification within one working day of execution of the Contract as required by Rule 25-17.0832(1)(a), F.A.C.

Rule 25-17.0832(1), F.A.C., requires that a utility provide in its notification the amount of committed capacity and the type of generating unit, if any, which the contracted capacity is intended to avoid or defer. The committed capacity is expected to be 5.25 MW. Manatee's facility will use landfill gas as a fuel, and will be a "renewable generating facility" within the meaning of Section 366.91F.S. and Rule 25-17.210(1).

The Contract contains negotiated terms and conditions consistent with the economic and operating characteristics of a simple cycle combustion turbine, which was FPL's avoided unit during 2006 when Manatee initiated contract discussions. The facility can reasonably be expected to contribute, on a proportional basis, the capacity benefits of such a unit.

FPL plans to file with the Commission within a short period of time a summary of the Contract pursuant to Rule 25-17.0832(b), F.A.C., as well as a petition requesting that the Commission approve the Contract as prudent for cost recovery purposes.
