So how are we supposed to sell power to our tenant ? What model of financial payback are we going to be allowed to use ? If you don't tell us what financial model we're allowed to use then how will people do this? Why can't we just use the per kWh method ? It's straight forward, all the IOUs use it and it is a fair system. If we have to sell power based on an equipment lease – how can we match usage and system cost ? It will have the effect of crippling the initiative as nobody will understand how to set up a financial model that works. What are we supposed to do, set up a lease that expires monthly and recalibrates each month based on the "profitability" of the system from last month's usage ? That effectively bypasses what I think the regulation says and still achieves the per kWh method – so why don't we just do it per kWh in the first place instead of making us figure out how to bypass completely unworkable rules?

If you make it hard to explain to investors and make it so we can't bill per kWh, then you will have effectively killed the initiative. I don't think that's your goal.

Most of this looks good but if we can't sell power based on a simple to follow mathematical formula, nobody will invest and what have we gained ?

Real progress will only happen if we are not considered public utilities and if we can bill by a completely transparent method like using the per kWh which everyone understands.

Please let me know how I am supposed to sell power and calculate a payback for investors so I can finally get off the sidelines and get moving on this.






