ORDER CONVERTING A CHAPTER 11 CASE TO A CHAPTER 7 CASE

For good cause shown, it is

ORDERED that the above captioned bankruptcy case is hereby converted from 11 U.S.C. Chapter 11 to 11 U.S.C. Chapter 7. A master address list (in matrix form), conforming to the requirements of Local Rules and this court's pertinent standing order, containing the name and address of each unpaid post-petition creditor, together with a separate schedule of unpaid debts incurred after the commencement of this case, shall be filed by the debtor(s) within 20 days following the entry of this order; and the debtor(s) shall furnish copies to the Chapter 7 Trustee and the U.S. Trustee. Within the time limits proscribed thereunder, the debtor(s) shall file all statements and schedules required by 11 U.S.C. §1112 or by Rules 1007 and 1019 F.R.Bk.P., if not already filed, and shall furnish copies to the Chapter 7 Trustee and the U.S. Trustee. As required by Rule 1019, F.R.Bk.P., the Chapter 11 Trustee and/or debtor in possession forthwith shall turn over to the Chapter 7 Trustee all records and property of the estate in the possession or control of the Chapter 11 Trustee and/or debtor in possession and shall furnish the U.S. Trustee and file with the Clerk of this court a final report and account within 30 days following the entry of this order.
