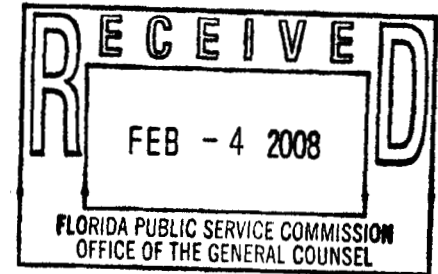

Dear Chairman Carter:

I read with great concern the PSC staff recommendation regarding the Manatee Green Power renewable energy contract. As you know, I am chairman of the committee in the Senate that has discussed and produced energy policy for this State; I am also the Senator in whose district this project is proposed. More important, I am a private citizen who has been a vocal advocate of renewable energy for years. This proposal seems to be a step backward rather than a step forward.

We have a chance here to establish renewable energy benefits as a component of utility regulatory policy that aligns with legislative policy. When you suggest that shareholders pay for renewable energy benefits you have established the program as voluntary since they can discontinue at any time. This would have the same regulatory significance as a charitable contribution. When you establish this practice as part of a regulatory philosophy in the ratemaking process there will be no turning back. It is time to definitely place renewable energy as part of our energy mix in Florida. All citizens of the state will benefit. This is considerably different than a charitable contribution. In addition, this will encourage new renewable energy projects which we desperately need.

This is not a PURDA or a federal issue. It is an issue of our state's renewable policy. Cost recovery for environmental benefits associated with renewable energy will be important to make sure that these benefits remain in our state. You need to provide leadership on this issue and establish the fact that renewable energy will be an established component of our framework, not a voluntary component that exists at the whim of the utilities.



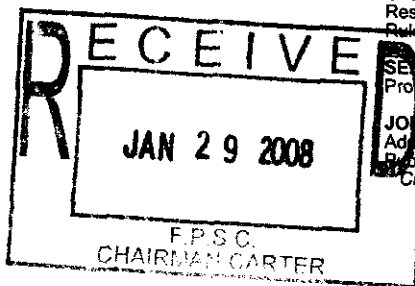
