This letter, pursuant to Rule 25-30.430, Florida Administrative Code, requests approval of a test year for Wedgefield Utilities, Inc. (the "Company"). The Company intends to submit an application for general rate relief to the Florida Public Service Commission for its water and wastewater systems located in Orange County, Florida. The Company intends to submit the minimum filing requirements ("MFRs") on or before January 31, 2008.


due to customer growth; adding MIEX treatment units to remove total sulfides and dissolved organic carbon; and obtaining renewal of its Consumptive Use Permit. The Company has also expended substantial amounts to maintain, upgrade and refurbish its wastewater system, including refurbishment of East Plant after completing installation of West Plant; converting the disinfection system to liquid chlorine; installing headworks improvements; installing VFDs at three lift stations; installing a reject pump station; and replacing a pond liner in an effluent storage pond.

The Company will include in its filing major pro forma plant additions, including expanding water treatment plant capacity, upgrading the type of treatment used, performing maintenance on the wastewater treatment plant and lift stations, modifying the Wedgefield CUP, testing the wastewater treatment plant load capacity and improving the wastewater treatment plant process blower. The Company will also include in its filing pro forma salaries, employee benefits and taxes (payroll, income and other taxes).

Pursuant to Section 367.081(8), Florida Statutes, the Company requests that the Commission process this petition for rate relief using the proposed agency action procedure. The Company will also request interim rates based on the historic test year.
