CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY**

**COMES NOW**, TransAmerica Telecom, Inc. ("TTI") and in support of its Application to cancel its Registration as an intrastate interexchange providers states the following:

1. On September 14, 2006, TTI registered with the Florida Public Service Commission to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service which Registration was issued on September 15, 2006 in Docket No. 060627-TI.
2. Due to a change in the business direction of the company TTI no longer seeks to be a provider of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Florida.
3. Since the filing of the registration, TTI has neither provisioned service nor invoiced customers in the State of Florida. As a result, cancellation of TTI's Registration is reasonable and would not be unduly disruptive to the present or future public convenience.
