

**IOUs' JOINT MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME**

Pursuant to Florida Rule of Civil Procedure 1.090(b) and rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light, Progress Energy Florida, Inc., and Tampa Electric Company (collectively the "IOUs") hereby request an enlargement of time to file their testimony and exhibits. In support, the IOUs state:

1. The IOUs request an enlargement of time of four (4) days, in order to extend the due date for the IOUs' testimony and exhibits from January 10, 2008, as specified in the Order Establishing Procedure and Consolidating Dockets, to January 14, 2008, to ensure that the IOUs have adequate time after the holidays to sufficiently prepare and timely file testimony and exhibits.

2. The undersigned has communicated with the counsels of PCS White Springs Agricultural Chemicals, Inc. d/b/a PCS Phosphate – White Springs (Mr. James W. Brew) and the Florida Industrial Cogeneration Association (Mr. Richard A. Zambo). The undersigned has received their consent to an extension of four (4) days for the IOUs to file testimony and

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exhibits, with the understanding that the due dates for the Intervenor's testimony and exhibits, Staff's testimony and exhibits, if any, and Rebuttal testimony and exhibits would also be enlarged by four (4) days, for new due dates of February 18, 2008 for Intervenor's testimony and exhibits; March 3, 2008 for Staff's testimony and exhibits; and March 10, 2008 for Rebuttal testimony and exhibits.

3. The IOUs therefore request a Commission Order for an enlargement of four (4) days to extend all due dates for testimony and exhibits in these dockets, to ensure that all parties have adequate time to prepare and file testimony and exhibits.
