Dear Ms. Salak:

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida") and ITS Telecommunications Systems, Inc. ("ITS") intend to file a joint petition with the Florida Public Service Commission to request a transfer of certain territories in Martin County from the certificated area of ITS to AT&T Florida. The present boundary line between the companies' certificated areas bisects the planned subdivision and individual lots in the Sunlight Ranch development. The proposed boundary change will involve transferring a portion of the Sunlight Ranch development from the ITS Indiantown Exchange to the AT&T Florida Stuart Exchange and will better align the companies' exchange service areas; thereby rendering the boundary more usable in the provision of service.

There are no customers currently being served in the area to be transferred.

This notification is to fulfill the requirements of Florida Public Service Commission Rule 25-4.005, Transfer of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as to All or Portion of Service Area.
