2. I have reviewed the documents and information for which I am listed as an affiant in Exhibit C and which are included in Exhibit A to FPL's Request for Confidential Classification of information contained in the Florida Public Service Commission Staff's Review of Customer Data Security of Florida's Five Investor-Owned Electric Utilities. The documents or materials that I have reviewed and which are asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information contain security measures, systems, or procedures, which if disclosed, could harm FPL's interests to the detriment of its customers. To the best of my knowledge, FPL has maintained the confidentiality of this information.


