Dear Ms. McMurrian,

I am utterly flabbergasted at your recent vote to allow Progress Energy an outrageous 25% increase in my electric bill, and that of tens of thousands of my fellow Floridians. What on earth were you commissioners thinking? Who side are you all on anyway? From your actions, it is crystal clear that it is certainly not on the side of the consumers of this state, most of whom (myself included) are struggling to survive day-to-day in this time of economic collapse. Are you commissioners so far removed and alienated from these realities that we are facing that you just roll over for your corporate masters? What could have ever possessed you and your fellow cohorts to offer up the consumers of this state as a sacrificial offering to Progress Energy? This is so outrageously surreal and disappointing! But, maybe not so disappointing, since we have come to expect this kind of behavior from both elected and appointed "officials".

It is now quite obvious that your "Public Service Commission" is nothing more than a sham organization, a mere front of puppets for the very business wolves that you were supposedly appointed to safeguard against. May I remind you that Progress Energy is a private company that reports to its shareholders? As such, whatever expenses that they incur in making capital improvements to their

business, such as building nuclear power plants, should be theirs to bear, and that cost should not be foisted upon their customers with such a massive increase, especially since the concrete has not yet even been poured. I could understand an incremental increase of 5% or so per annum up to the 5th year, or until the 25% target has been reached, but allowing a massive 25% hit all at once is totally indefensible. With a family of 3 kids and only one wage earner, whom do I now turn to for a 'bailout', to be able to meet paying my power bill, with all of the other pressing bills and increases? What do you suggest that I and my fellow Floridians do, in times of extreme summer heat and winter's cold? We (my family) have cut back as much as we can to conserve energy and reduce our power bill, there is not any more to cut. Thanks for now forcing us to resort to candles. Thanks for nothing.

Ms. McMurrin, if you and your fellow "commissioners" are so woefully unable to fulfill the duties of your office - which I presume is to look out for the *best* interest of Floridian consumers- then I suggest that the honorable thing to do is to resign your post forthwith, at least to maintain your own sense of decency and honor. Granting a 25% whammy on consumers is only in the interest of the corporate giant, Progress Energy and their shareholders. I shudder to think of what other oppressively draconian concessions you and your fellow commissioners are preparing to visit on the bewildered and battered citizens of this state, under the auspices of the petitioning corporations, of course. We desperately need real watchdogs for consumers, not a phalanx of submissive "YES" people who are bent on sabotaging struggling families, as we seem to have right now.

Commissioners:

Crude oil for January delivery was last down 6 cents to \$49.36 a barrel in electronic trading. Earlier, it hit an intraday low of \$48.25. In January 2009 the rate increase your committee approved takes effect for Progress Energy customers. A twenty-four percent rate increase which I can not afford.

In 2006 Progress Energy contracts to purchase 3000 acres of land for a nuclear power plant and four coal fired generators. Our President elect and our Vice President elect have both reiterated in strong terms that under their administration there will be no development of coal power. According to Vice President elect Biden:

"Were not supporting clean coal. Guess what, China's building two every week, two dirt coal plants and its polluting the united states, its causing people to die."

1Sky reporter, "So, will you support wind and solar?"

Joe Biden answered, "Absolutely, before anybody did, the first guy to introduce a global warming bill was me, 22 years ago. The first guy to support solar energy was me, 26 years ago it came out of Delaware. But guess what, China's gonna burn 300 years of bad coal UNLESS WE FIGURE OUT HOW TO CLEAN THEIR COAL UP! because its going to ruin your lungs and there's nothing we can do about it. NO COAL PLANTS HERE IN AMERICA! Build them, if their going to build them, over there. Make them clean because they're killing you. See ya, thank you, thank you very, very, much."

From 2006 it had taken until March of 2008 to file a proposal with the NRC to apply for a permit for a nuclear power plant. In the meantime Progress Energy had used public utility funds to purchase naming rights to Al Lang Field in St. Petersburg as well as naming rights to the Bayfront Center in St. Petersburg. The cost for the Bayfront Center project is:

"Since 2001, Progress Energy has invested almost \$800,000 in the Florida Orchestra, Mahaffey Theater and the Salvador Dali Museum, some of the organizations that will be located in the Progress I

This is just locally. I am already paying a fuel surcharge and starting in January 2009 Progress Energy will start charging additional money to pay for a power plant that they have no approval for or the promise of an approval. In the meantime Progress Energy will continue to use public utility funds to rename more locations throughout the State of Florida.

In the last 2 years I have seen my homeowners insurance rates DOUBLE, my property tax DOUBLE and my property value fall. I can no longer afford the oversight that your committee provides year after year. With unemployment rates hovering between 7 and 8 percent exactly where is it you think people are going to come up with an additional 24% for a power bill? Is the PSC going to revisit this rate increase with the falling fuel prices? I have no more money to give you or anyone else. Enough is enough.

Dear Mr. Hennigan:

The Governor's office forwarded a copy of your e-mail regarding Progress Energy Florida, Incorporated (Progress Energy) to the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC). The PSC regulates investor-owned electric, natural gas, and telecommunications utilities throughout Florida, and investor-owned water and wastewater utilities in those counties which have opted to transfer jurisdiction to the PSC.

You expressed a concern about fuel adjustment charges. Fuel adjustment charges allow the utility to recover the actual expenses associated with securing and processing fuel necessary to run the power plants used to generate electricity. Fuel rates mirror rising and falling fuel costs as reflected in the international marketplace. The revenue generated by the fuel adjustment charge does not add to the profit of the utility companies, but goes to pay fuel suppliers and transporters. The cost of fuel is shown as a separate cents per kilowatt-hour charge, and fuel costs are not contained in any other charge on your bill.

Each year, utilities file their projected fuel expenses for the upcoming calendar year. The PSC, along with the Office of Public Counsel and other consumer representatives closely examine the fuel costs requested by the utilities. Public hearings are held annually to set the fuel factors for the next year. Since rates are set on projected costs, at the end of the year, the costs are "trued-up" or compared to the audited actual expenses incurred by the utility. If the utility recovered more than its actual costs, the amount of over-recovery is used to reduce the next year's costs. If the utility under-recovered (costs were higher than expected) that deficit is likewise rolled into the next year. The fuel cost adjustment is recognized by virtually all state commissions, by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, and is also used by most municipal electric utilities and rural electric cooperatives.

On November 13, 2008, the PSC set the 2009 fuel adjustment charges for the customers of Florida investor-owned electric utilities. **The fuel adjustment charges were decided at a hearing where the Commission considered each utility's projected costs of fuel and the purchased power for 2009 as well as 'trued up' costs for 2008.**

Below is the amount that Progress Energy residential customers paid for 1,000 kilowatt-hours of electricity prior to January 2009, as well as the amount that customers will pay effective January 2009.

Prior to January 2009 (1,000 kilowatt-hours)	\$110.59
As of January 2009 (1,000 kilowatt-hours)	\$137.87
Increase (1,000 kilowatt-hours)	\$27.28

Complaints serve as a valuable source of information; therefore, your complaint will remain on file with the PSC. We monitor complaints very closely and track any trends which indicate there may be a problem and further action is needed.

We were recently informed that the Public Service Commission has agreed to a fuel adjustment increase for Florida Progress. This is the second increase since this summer when they were granted a six percent (6%) fuel adjustment increase. The most recent increase we understand will be twenty-eight percent (28%). (For a total increase of 34% on the fuel adjustment portion of the utility bill).

In light of the significant decline in the cost of oil from a high of \$148 /barrel this fall to approximately \$54 /barrel, (the lowest cost per barrel in the past two years), it now seems appropriate to reverse this additional 28% increase. We would, therefore, respectfully suggest that the Public Service Commission call an emergency meeting to reverse the 28% increase. for the following reasons:

1. Due to the dramatic decline in the cost of oil from \$148/barrel to \$50-\$54/barrel, the increase is no longer warranted.
2. Current economic conditions certainly warrant providing this relief, in light of the precarious condition of so many businesses in Florida which need all the assistance they can receive. This is particularly true in the hospitality industry (which drives the state's economy) where the additional 28% increase will be very painful and may result in a number of hotels and restaurants going out of business.
3. Indeed, this 34% increase could very well be the final straw for hundreds of small businesses throughout the state of Florida who desperately need relief, not additional pain.

Note: At the end of the fiscal year, should the cost of oil increase, then appropriate adjustments could be made; but for the time being it is much more important to save businesses by providing them with relief than it is to provide a public utility with funds they would merely place in a savings account, generating interest earnings.

FPL Group, the primary power provider in Manatee, Sarasota and Charlotte counties, said its third quarter profits rose 45 percent to \$774 million, or \$1.92 per share on revenue of \$5.39 billion.

The parent company of Florida Power & Light now expects it will earn something on the low end of its yearly profit projection of \$3.83-\$3.85.

FPL Group reaffirmed its forecasts for 2009 and 2010.

Excluding extraordinary gains, earnings were \$1.25 per share in the third quarter, below analysts' average forecast of \$1.35 per share.

The company's shares, which trade on the New York

The Juno Beach-based FPL Group, which is the largest operator of wind-power generation in the United States, said it will trim its 2009 spending because of the economic slump. The company said it would cut

2009 spending on wind generation by nearly 25 percent to \$5.3 billion. The company will add 1,100 megawatts rather than the 1,500 megawatts it originally had planned.

So far this year, FPL has put 499 megawatts of new wind capacity on line and is on track to reach a total of 1,300 megawatts for the year, about equivalent to one large coal-fired power plant.

FPL Energy, the company's wholesale power business, has nearly 5,100 megawatts of wind generation at more than 50 sites in 16 states.

The company has said it hopes to add 8,000 to 10,000 megawatts to its portfolio through 2012.

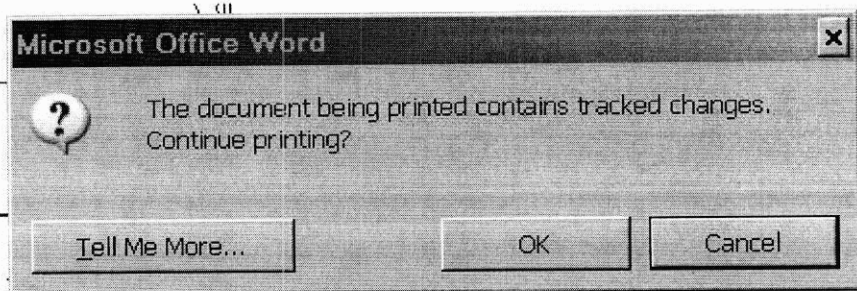

I am writing to follow-up on our request for the Commission's deferral of Items 2 and 3 from the Staff recommendation on FPL's January 31, 2008, Petition for Approval of Improved Volatility Mitigation Mechanism ("VMM Petition") that was issued April 14, 2008, in the above-referenced docket. FPL would propose that those items be brought back before the Commission at the agenda conference scheduled for July 15, 2008, after Staff has completed the two hedging audits that are currently being conducted, and allowing time for further discussions with relevant parties.

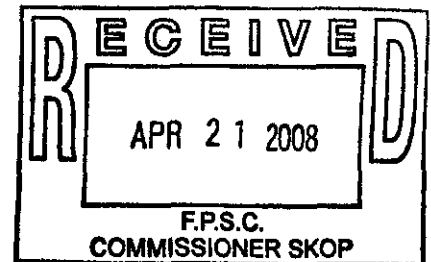
While one of the concerns expressed in the Staff recommendation was that Issues 2 and 3 were premature until the hedging audits are complete, Staff also expressed other concerns about FPL's VMM proposal and its alternative hedging guidelines that were unrelated to the timing of FPL's request. FPL believes that it would be useful to meet with Staff and the other affected parties while the audits are being completed, to see if common ground can be reached on improvements to the existing hedging process that could be taken to the Commission as a proposed stipulation at the July 15 agenda conference. If Staff agrees, I ask that Staff schedule an informal workshop for this purpose in the near future.

As noted in the VMM Petition, FPL needs to begin placing hedges for 2009 in the Spring of this year, in order to implement those hedges in an orderly and efficient manner. Of course, this means that FPL will need to begin hedging well before the July 15 agenda conference. FPL intends to begin placing hedges for 2009 on or around May 1. The 2009 hedges will be consistent with FPL's approved Risk Management Plan and generally in accordance with the guidelines that were proposed as Exhibit 3 to the VMM Petition, taking into consideration Staff's concerns regarding an overly prescriptive approach.
