1 25-24.516 Pay Telephone Rate Caps.

(1) For the following types of services, the rRates charged any end user by a pay telephone 2 provider, providing operator service within the pay telephone premises' equipment, shall not 3 4 exceed the following: 5 (a) Local coin calls – the rate posted at the pay telephone station. 6 (b) Extended area service (EAS) coin calls – a rate equivalent to the local coin call rate. 7 (c) Extended calling scope (ECS) calls – the rate equivalent to the local coin rate. (2) For the following types of services, the Commission shall adjust the maximum rates 8 9 annually based on the change in the Gross Domestic Product Fixed 1987 Weights Price Index less one percent. The adjusted rates shall take effect upon a final Commission order. 10 11 (ad) 0+ toll non-person-to-person. <u>- a maximum rate of \$.30 per minute, plus a \$1.75 charge</u>. (be) 0+ toll person-to-person. <u>a maximum rate of \$.30 per minute, plus a \$3.25 charge</u>. 12 (cf) 0+ non-person-to-person local. — a rate equivalent to the local coin rate, plus a \$1.75 13 14 charge. 15 (dg) 0+ toll person-to-person local. — a rate equivalent to the local coin rate, plus a \$3.25 16 charge. 17 (32) A pay telephone provider shall not obtain services from an interexchange carrier or an 18 operator service provider unless such carrier or provider has either obtained a certificate of 19 public convenience and necessity or registered with the Commission whichever is appropriate. 20 21 Specific Authority 350.127(2) FS. - 4 Domestic Product Fixed 1987 Weights Price Index less one percent. The adjusted rates shall

- 6 | Services charged and billed to any end-user by an operator services provider for an intrastate
- 7 0+ or 0- call-made from a pay telephone or in a call aggregator context shall not exceed a rate
