YOU ARE COMMANDED to appear at <u>The Public Service Commission</u>, <u>Capitol Circle Complex Center</u>, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, <u>Tallahassee</u>, <u>Florida</u>, on <u>February 7</u>, 2008, at 9:00 <u>a</u>.m., or at such other time and place as may be mutually agreed upon by counsel, and to have with you at that time and place the following:

Written responses to the following questions:

- 1. For any service that AT&T-Florida sells to Nexus Communications Inc. (Nexus) for the provision of residential access service, be it unbundled network elements (UNE) or resale, please detail the charge, if any, that AT&T-Florida assesses Nexus for toll limitation service (TLS). If a charge is assessed, and the information is readily available, provide a breakdown, by month, for the charge that was billed to Nexus for TLS service, along with the number and type of service (UNE or resale). We would like this information for every month that Nexus has been a customer of either BellSouth-Florida or AT&T-Florida.
- 2. Does AT&T-Florida receive any reimbursement from USAC through the Link-Up program for costs related to connecting Lifeline customers on resold lines for Nexus? If so, how much? Is this reimbursement passed on to Nexus in the form of a credit?
- 3. Does AT&T-Florida receive any reimbursement from USAC for costs related to TLS provided on resold lines to Nexus? If so, how much? Is this reimbursement passed on to Nexus in the form of a credit?
- 4. Please detail the number of access lines that have been sold to Nexus, for every month that Nexus has been a customer of either BellSouth-Florida or AT&T-Florida. Please show separately the number of UNE lines and resold lines, by month, and indicate how many are Lifeline lines.
- 5. Are Lifeline subsidies claimed by AT&T-Florida, and then passed on to Nexus in the form of a credit? If so, how much of a monthly credit is passed on?
- 6. Did Nexus have a commercial agreement with BellSouth in 2007? Please confirm AT&T's understanding of Nexus' status, as either a facility based provider (UNE, UNE-P, or their own equipment) or strictly a reseller for 2007.
- 7. What does AT&T-Florida charge to Nexus as a connection fee for the typical residential customer? Is this fee the same for Lifeline customers?

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- 8. Please provide copies of the monthly BellSouth-Florida/AT&T-Florida invoices sent to Nexus for each month BellSouth-Florida/AT&T-Florida provided service to Nexus in Florida. If the monthly invoices are too voluminous, please provide copies of just the latest month's billing.
 - 9. Is Nexus current regarding payments to BellSouth-Florida / AT&T-Florida?

These items will be inspected and may be copied at that time. You will not be required to surrender the original items. You may comply with this subpoena by providing legible copies of the items to be produced to the attorney whose name appears on this subpoena on or before the scheduled date of production. You may mail or deliver the copies to the attorney whose name appears on this subpoena and thereby eliminate your appearance at the time and place specified above. You have the right to object to the production pursuant to this subpoena at any time before production by giving written notice to the attorney whose name appears on this subpoena. THIS WILL NOT BE A DEPOSITION. NO TESTIMONY WILL BE TAKEN.

YOU ARE SUBPOENAED by the following attorney to (1) appear as specified, or (2) furnish the records instead of appearing as provided above, and, unless excused from this subpoena by this attorney or the Commission, you shall respond to this subpoena as directed.
