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**REQUEST FOR ORAL ARGUMENT**

JEA, pursuant to Rule 25-22.058, Florida Administrative Code, by and through its undersigned counsel, file this Request for Oral Argument and in support thereof state as follows:

1. On January 23, 2008 JEA filed its Motion for Reconsideration before the full Commission requesting that the limitations on its intervention and the striking of Issues 14, 16, 17-20 raised by JEA and other electric utilities be reversed.
2. Due to the fact that this proceeding is the first time that the Commission will determine a need for a completely new nuclear power plant under modifications to both §403.519, Fla. Stat. (2007) and Rule 25-22.081, F.A.C., the full Commission would benefit from oral argument on the issues raised in the Motion for Reconsideration. These issues regarding the interpretation of §403.519(4)(a)5, Fla. Stat. (2007), and Rule 25-22.081(2)(d), F.A.C., are complex issues of first impression which will have substantial impacts on future nuclear power plant need determinations. Oral argument will aid the Commission in reaching a just and fair result.

WHEREFORE, JEA requests that this Commission allow oral argument on its Motion for Reconsideration at its earliest convenience.

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
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
