Dear Mr. Rieger:

San Sebastian Water, LLC proposes to extend its water service territory from its eastern boundary on the south side of Daytona west of US Highway 1 across the highway to the property shown in the exhibits. This service extension is a quick take of less than 25 ERU's and is currently not served by any other utility. The following items are provided as per Chapter 25-30.036 F.A.C.:

- (a) San Sebastian Water, LLC; 5800 13th Street, Micco, FL 32976
- (d) This water treatment plant has certificate #439-W, a copy of the Property Appraiser's information is enclosed. The proof of ownership of the property is attached.
- (e) An exhibit showing the property to be served is attached.
- (i) The property tax assessment map is attached as an exhibit.
- (m) The subject property to be served is a commercial marina site.
- (o) Three copies of the tariff sheets for San Sebastian Water, LLC are attached.
- (p) The additional service territory equates to an additional 9 ERUs.
- (q) The current certificate number for San Sebastian Water, LLC is 439-W.

TECHNICAL TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS

- 1.0 "BFC" – The abbreviation for "Base Facility Charge" which is the minimum amount the Company may charge its Customers and is separate from the amount the Company bills its Customers for water consumption.
- 2.0 "CERTIFICATE" – A document issued by the Commission authorizing the Company to provide water service in a specific territory.
- 3.0 "COMMISSION" – The shortened name for the Florida Public Service Commission.
- 4.0 "COMMUNITIES SERVED" – The group of Customers who receive water service from the Company and whose service location is within a specific area or locality that is uniquely separate from another.
- 5.0 "COMPANY" – The shortened name for the full name of the utility which is San Sebastian Water, LLC.
- 6.0 "CUSTOMER" – Any person, firm, or corporation who has entered into an agreement to receive water service from the Company and who is liable for the payment of that water service.
- 7.0 "CUSTOMER'S INSTALLATION" – All pipes, shut-offs, valves, fixtures, and appliances or apparatus of every kind and nature used in connection with or forming a part of the installation for rendering water service to the Customer's side of the Service Connection whether such installation is owned by the Customer or used by the Customer under lease or other agreement.
- 8.0 "MAIN" – A pipe, conduit, or other facility used to convey water service to individual service lines or through other mains.
- 9.0 "RATE" – Amount which the Company may charge for water service which is applied to the Customer's actual consumption.
- 10.0 "RATE SCHEDULE" – The rate(s) or charge(s) for a particular classification of service plus the several provisions necessary for billing, including all special terms and conditions under which service shall be furnished at such rate or charge.

- 11.0 "SERVICE" – As mentioned in this tariff and in agreement with Customers, "Service" shall be construed to include, in addition to all water service required by the Customer, the readiness and ability on the part of the Company to furnish water service to the Customer. Service shall conform to the standards set forth in Section 367.111 of the Florida Statutes.
- 12.0 "SERVICE CONNECTION" - The point where the Company's pipes or meters are connected with the pipes of the Customer.
- 13.0 "SERVICE LINES" – The pipes between the Company's Mains and the Service Connection and which include all the pipes, fittings, and valves necessary to make the connection to the Customer's premises, excluding the meter.
- 14.0 "TERRITORY" – The geographical area described, if necessary, by metes and bounds but, in all cases, with township, range, and section in a Certificate, which may be within or without the boundaries of an incorporated municipality and may include areas in more than one county.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1.0 GENERAL INFORMATION – These Rules and Regulations are a part of the rate schedules and applications and contracts of the Company and, in the absence of specific written agreement to the contrary, apply without modifications or change to each and every Customer to whom the Company renders water service.
- The Company shall provide water service to all Customers requiring such service within its Certificated territory pursuant to Chapter 25-30, Florida Administrative Code and Chapter 367, Florida Statutes.
- 2.0 POLICY DISPUTE – Any dispute between the Company and the Customer or prospective Customer regarding the meaning or application of any provision of this tariff shall upon written request by either party be resolved by the Florida Public Service Commission.
- 3.0 APPLICATION – In accordance with Rule 25-30.310, Florida Administrative Code, a signed application is required prior to the initiation of service. The Company shall provide each Applicant with a copy of the brochure entitled "Your Water and Wastewater Service," prepared by the Florida Public Service Commission.
- 4.0 APPLICATIONS BY AGENTS - Applications for water service requested by firms, partnerships, associations, corporations, and others shall be rendered only by duly authorized parties or agents. When water service is rendered under agreement or agreements entered into between the company and an agent of the principal, the use of such water service by the principal shall constitute full and complete ratification by the principal of the agreement or agreements entered into between agent and the company and under which such water service is rendered.
- 5.0 REFUSAL OR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE – The Company may refuse or discontinue water service rendered under application made by any member or agent of a household, organization, or business in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code.
- 6.0 EXTENSIONS – Extensions will be made to the Company's facilities in compliance with Commission Rules and Orders and the Company's tariff.

- 7.0 TYPE AND MAINTENANCE – In accordance with Rule 25-30.545, Florida Administrative Code, the Customer's pipes, apparatus, and equipment shall be selected, installed, used and maintained in accordance with standard practice and shall conform with the Rules and Regulations of the Company and shall comply with all laws and governmental regulations applicable to same. The Company shall not be responsible for the maintenance and operation of the Customer's pipes and facilities. The Customer expressly agrees not to utilize any appliance or device which is not properly constructed, controlled, and protected or which may adversely affect the water service. The Company reserves the right to discontinue or withhold water service to such apparatus or device.
- 8.0 DELINQUENT BILLS – When it has been determined that a Customer is delinquent in paying any bill, water service may be discontinued after the Company has mailed or presented a written notice to the Customer in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code. Bills are due when rendered, and if not paid within twenty (20) days thereafter become delinquent and water service may after days written notice be discontinued. Service will be resumed only upon payment of all past-due bills and penalties, together with a reconnection charge. There shall be no liability of any kind against the company by reason of discontinuance of water service to the consumer for failure of the customer to pay the bills on time. No partial payment of any bill rendered will be accepted by the company, except by agreement with company, or by order or direction of the Commission.
- 9.0 CONTINUITY OF SERVICE – In accordance with Rule 25-30.250, Florida Administrative Code, the Company will at

Dear Mr. Whalen:

This letter is to summarize our meeting today whereby Sebastian Inlet Marina, LLC (the "Customer") expressed its desire to acquire potable water service from San Sebastian Water, LLC (the "Utility Company"). At the meeting, the Utility Company expressed its desire to extend potable water service to the Customer from its treatment facilities located at 8800 Seventh Avenue, Micco, Brevard County, Florida (the "Treatment Facilities") and existing water distribution system (the "Distribution Lines").

General

The Utility Company is the sole owner of the Treatment Facilities and the Distribution Lines. The Utility Company operates its facilities under the jurisdiction of the Florida Public Service Commission (the "PSC"), Florida Department of Environmental Protection (the "FDEP") and Brevard County Florida (the "County"); and, all the required operating permits have been obtained and are in good standing with those authorities. The treatment facilities have the physical capacity to add additional potable water customers to its service area, including provision of 1,000 GPM fire flow capacity @55 psi.

The Customer is the developer of Sebastian Inlet Marina which is located at 8685 US-1, Micco, Brevard County, Florida (the "Marina"). The Marina property boundary is located approximately 1,000 feet from the intersection of Daytona Boulevard and 3rd Avenue, the closest probable connection point to the Distribution Lines. Furthermore, the Marina is not currently served by a public utility, and it is currently outside the Utility Company service area.

Regulatory, Design and Permitting

Prior to entering into a formal Utility Service Agreement, the Utility Company will be required to obtain formal approval (from the PSC, DEP, County and other agencies that might have jurisdiction in such a matter) to expand its water service territory to include the Marina. Such approval(s) will include (unless already approved and in effect) expansion of the franchise territory, water consumption rates, connection charges, plant capacity fees, main extension fees and any other issues associated with extension of service as contemplated in this letter.

The Customer will, subject to the approval of the Utility Company, select and engage a civil engineering firm to design and permit the water main extension to east side of highway US-1 at the Marina facility. Any such design will require the approval of the Utility Company, prior to any submissions for final construction permitting. The Customer will also be responsible for design and permitting of any potable water distribution and fire protection systems within its boundaries.

At the time of entering into the formal Utility Service Agreement, the Utility Company will be required to certify that it is authorized to do business in Florida; that the connection is legal from a permit and regulatory standpoint; and that the Utility has sufficient plant capacity, water pressure and fire storage capacity to serve the Marina facility.

Line Extension Costs

The Customer will fund the cost of design, permitting, and construction of the main line extension from the existing Distribution Lines to the Marina property as designed and approved. It is expected that these costs will include (without limitation) engineering, development permits, tap-in to existing Distribution Lines, excavation & restoration of property in / along the road right of way, and boring under highway US-1 (collectively, the "Line Extension Costs"). At the completion of construction, an accounting of the Line Extension Costs and a set of as-built drawings will be provided to the Utility Company by the Customer; and the improvements will be dedicated to and accepted for ownership by the Utility Company.

The Utility Company and the Customer will enter into a Refundable Advance Agreement in an amount equal to the Line Extension Costs, less the Customer "fair share" of the cost of the extension line. The Agreement will provide that (for a period of ten years) the Customer is entitled to recover the refundable portion of the Line Extension Costs from the "line extension fees" imposed by the utility upon any new customer who connects to the extension line that was funded by the Customer.

Other Connection Costs

The Customer will pay for normal costs associated with a connection to a utility main at the Marina site, including (without limitation) tap-in cost, water meter, back-flow preventer, and on-site distribution lines.

The Customer will also pay for plant capacity (water impact fees) and other charges as listed in the Utility Company tariff approved by the PSC. For purposes of these fees, average daily consumption in terms of equivalent residential units (ERU) for the Marina will be determined based on assumptions for a marina within other Brevard County water systems. The Customer has estimated its peak average daily consumption to be 2,150 GPD, as reflected on the attached exhibit.

Plant Operating / Consumption Charges

The Customer will pay for actual consumption based upon the Utility Company tariff approved by the PSC in a manner similar to other customers of the Utility.


Other Matters

commitment from your organization as soon as possible, as we need to connect to the utility system no later than May 2008).






