To Both TECO and Cutrale Citrus Juice

Please be prepared to respond to the following questions at the informal conference:

Does Cutrale Citrus Juice use 13 kv for all or part of its facilities or does it step down all of its service to 4 kv?

If Cutrale Citrus Juice has been stepping down all of its service to 4kv – when did it commence doing so? Did it request service from TECO at 4kv? If yes, when did it make its request to TECO? Provide documentation.

If Cutrale Citrus Juice had requested 4kv delivery from the utility and provided the transformation from 13kv to 4kv in order to be billed at the 13 kv level, what would be the difference in charges?
