

**JOINT STATUS REPORT OF  
WITHLACOOCHEE RIVER ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE AND PROGRESS ENERGY FLORIDA**

Re: Territorial Agreement Customer Transfers

This status report is submitted pursuant to Commission Order No. PSC-05-0965-PAA-EU, issued October 10, 2005 in Docket No. 040133-EU, which approved the currently effective territorial agreement between Withlacoochee River Electric Cooperative (“WREC”) and Progress Energy Florida, Inc. (“PEF”).

**WREC / PEF Customer Transfer Updates:**

Under “Phase 2” of the customer transfers delineated in the currently effective territorial agreement between WREC and PEF, the following transfers have been completed since February 2007:

- North of County Line Road – Hernando County: 596 PEF customers have been transferred to WREC; completed on August 1, 2007.
- North Dunnellon, Triangle S. of Dunnellon Road, W. Riverwood Drive – Citrus County: 369 PEF customers have been transferred to WREC; completed on December 13, 2007.
- North of Whitman Road – Hernando County: 305 PEF customers have been transferred to WREC; completed on March 13, 2008.
- North Broad Street & Howell Road – Hernando County: 8 PEF customers have been transferred to WREC; completed on March 13, 2008.
- Zephyrhills – East Pasco County: 694 WREC customers have been transferred to PEF; completed on August 24, 2007.
- Zephyrhills – East Pasco County: 401 WREC customers have been transferred to PEF; completed on December 13, 2007.
- An additional 165 (approx.) Exhibit B customers are scheduled to be transferred from WREC to PEF in Hernando and Citrus Counties on April 7 – 8, 2008.

The status of the remaining customer transfers to be effectuated under the current territorial agreement is as follows:

- Zephyrhills – E. Pasco County: Approximately 689 WREC customers remain to be transferred to PEF. PEF and WREC are filing a joint petition to amend the current territorial agreement to request additional time to effectuate this transfer.
