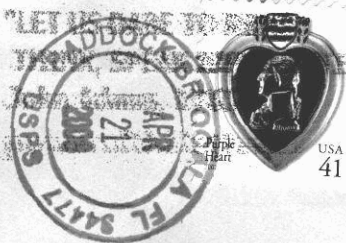

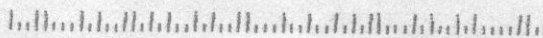

I already pay for water and sewer usage. So, the proposed added price of 29.50 for 5,000 gals or less is totally unfair and unacceptable.

I own the house, I pay for rubbish collection, for the grass to be cut and shrubbery pruned and for this month for the house to be power washed because I got a letter saying I had to because there was some mold on back of house that I couldn't reach to wipe off, and a lot of black on walks because I down spouts empty onto cement walk so, used more water this month.

The monthly fee I pay is for lot rent, care of common grounds and water and sewer. The fee has gone up every year since I'm here - Sept. 19, 2004. Also they bill me in Jan. for \$41.99 for fire protection and solid waste assessments. I was not told of that expense when I moved in.

buying, only about the 2 tags in Dec.
I sell my house in Oak Run because
I had a mortgage and could no longer
afford it. Now, in being pushed
out of here. I have a low income.
My husband was a policeman in
Dgh, Pa. for 22 yrs. He paid into
Survivors Benefits; died 1988.
I get \$350 a month, and they
won't raise it. He did other jobs
so I get now \$91.00 S.S. This yr
it went up \$12., and fee, settlement
up \$14.91, so I can't even stay even.
I don't eat out, or go to movies,
can't afford to pay taxis, I don't
buy any extras. Last year I gave
up one prescription for a pain
med. And I have a lot of pain. Some
pain from Guillain Barre, and
arthritis in neck, back, rt. hip (bad)
and knee. Left hip was replaced
before H B S. And I used to get ~~help~~
household help from Sr. Louise, but
that was cancelled to help pay for war.
I'll be 84 this year, one leg paralyzed,
other nerve damage, arms and hand

a long time except some chipped
ham from Walmart.

So, they've got me between a rock
and a hard place. If I'm put
out of here where can I go?

My house can't sell because it is
near sewerage treatment and odor.
Sometime I get sick at stomach
from it. And sometimes there is
a terrible annoying whistling
from it. It shouldn't be allowed.
Some one should do something about
that.

I know you people in Tallahassee
have no idea how hard it is to get along
on a low income. If I had any money I
could go to dentist; some fillings and crowns
come out. My D. Dr. has an annual
fee of \$200. Even if I had no medical
attention for a year, that wouldn't
pay the fee you're asking.

I'm sure we'll win in court
because anybody can see how

unfairness.

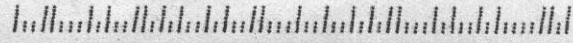

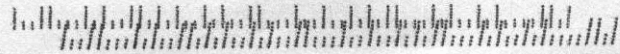
